## 1. OPENING SIGNAL

Sci-Chi is not simply science fiction with faith added afterward. It is a way of telling stories where technology, artificial intelligence, alien worlds, broken systems, and future civilizations become pressure chambers for the human soul. The question is not only, Can we do this? The deeper question is, What does doing this reveal about us?

## 2. SCIENCE IS THE SETTING, NOT THE GOD

Sci-Chi respects science, discovery, invention, intelligence, space, biology, history, and the strange possibilities of the universe. But it does not treat science as the final authority over meaning. Science can describe what is measurable. It cannot, by itself, explain why mercy matters, why truth should be chosen, or why a person is more than their function.

## 3. TECHNOLOGY REVEALS THE HUMAN SOUL

Every tool extends the person who uses it. A machine can amplify wisdom, but it can also amplify pride. A system can protect the vulnerable, but it can also erase them. Sci-Chi does not treat technology as the villain. The danger is usually older than the machine. The machine reveals the heart.

Sci-Chi is speculative fiction where science becomes the stage, technology becomes the test, and the human soul becomes the central question.
